Firewood

You can purchase wood along with your ticket. Wood will be seasoned and tarped, and costs \$15 per wheelbarrow. Depending on weather, we may provide sleds in place of wheelbarrows for transport. If you think your theme camp or group will need more wood, cords can be purchased for \$150. Once you are on site firewood will cost \$20 per wheelbarrow.

Information about Camp Kevin.

Camp Kevin is a primitive site. There are no heated bathrooms, a very limited road system, and no electricity. There are wide open fields for your tundra palaces and enough room in the woods for tents and ez-ups.

Gate will be at the bottom of a hill. The left side of the hill is a more gradual slope that will lead to the main field. To the right of the gradual slope it gets steep: steep enough for skiing, snowboarding, sledding and whatever other downward moving activities you can dream up. Want to get back up to go back down? Take the tow line.

The Barn is a staple at Camp Kevin and Frostburn has been invited to hang out and play inside. It's a nice space with a fantastic sound system that will be open for use on Saturday. Look for more details soon.

Parking.

Car access to your campsite will be weather dependent. You may be able to drive to your campsite; if not, there are two easily accessible parking lots near Gate and The Barn. There will be a separate area for RV and car camping. There are no electric hookups for RVs.
